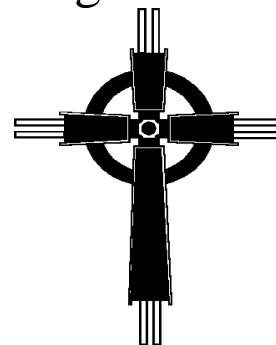
Defibrillator. We would like to install a defibrillator on our buildings. It will cost c £2,000 Could you contribute?
