St Aidan's 2019 Text cards are now available. Please do take one. Gordon's sermon preached on the text on 30th December is available on the web-site.

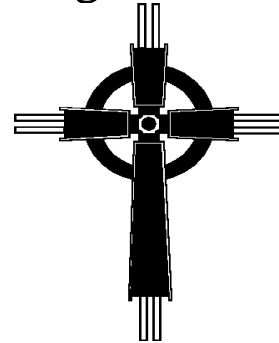
The Aidan Players present **Hansel and Gretel**, a Family Pantomime.
