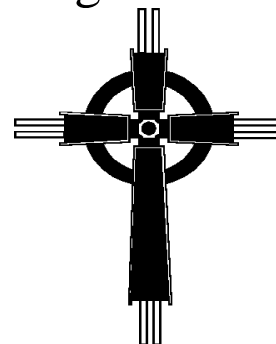
Keith Bevell would be pleased to receive any **Children's Society boxes**, for counting and sending. Thank you.
