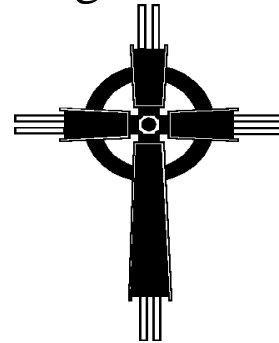
St Aidan's has been chosen as a recipient
