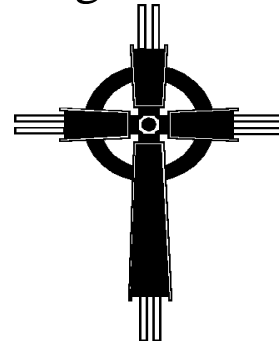
St Aidan's Finances:
