St Aidan's Text cards for 2021 are now available in the chapel. You can read a sermon by Gordon on this text on our web-site.

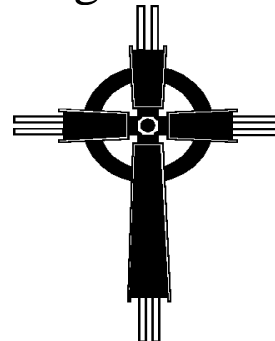
Stop Press!
