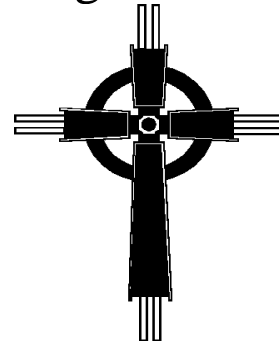
**Daily Hope** offers music, prayers, and reflections, as well as full worship services from the Church of England. The line is available 24 hours a day on **0800 804 8044**
